
The next stated communication of Fountain Valley 191 will be April 3rd, 2018 at 7:30pm.

Notable dates in Masonic History;

1696: The first recorded ritual, found in the Edinburgh Register House manuscript.

Thanks to this record we can imagine what a Masonic ritual in the late 1600s would be like, and it shows the earliest evidence of a two-degree system. The third degree first appeared quite a few years later, somewhere between 1723 and 1730, and it spread slowly within the craft until it became part of the Masonic system.

If not directly related to the Legend of Hiram, it does give guidance to the Masonic Lodge, in imitation of the Temple of Solomon, and provides two important symbolic elements of the degree of Master Mason to come: the five points of the Fellowship and the Mason Word which, when integrated into the ritual of the degree, will be the five points of Fellowship of the Master's degree and the Master's Word itself.
