December 14, 1784

Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart, an Austrian composer and son of a Freemason, Mozart created a number of masonic musical numbers during his prolific career. He was a part of the Zur Wohltätigkeit (Charity) Lodge, Austria.

When his father received his masonic Second Degree Wolfgang wrote "Fellow Crafts Journey (Op. K468) to honor the occasion.

Initiated: December 14, 1784, lodge Zur Woltatigkeit Passed: January 7, 1785 Raised: before April 22, 1785, Lodge Zur Wahren Eintracht
