Notable dates in Masonic History;

March 6, 1775 – Prince Hall, made a Master Mason in Irish Constitution Military Lodge No. 441

Having been rejected by colonial Freemasonry, Hall and 14 others sought and were initiated into Masonry through Lodge No. 441 of the Grand Lodge of Ireland, March 6, 1775. The military lodge was attached to the 38th Foot (renamed "The 1st Staffordshire Regiment") in 1782. Masonry was attractive to some free blacks because freemasonry was founded upon ideals of liberty, equality and peace.

March 12, 1807 – Albert Gallatin Mackey, Masonic Author

March 14, 1876 – Grand Commander of Colorado established

March 17, 1856 – Grand Lodge of Kansas established, Wyandotte County, Kansas

March 18, 1919 – Order of DeMolay founded in Kansas City, Missouri

March 25, 1882 – Grand Lodge of Arizona was established in Tucson
