Notable dates in Masonic History;

- -Grand Lodge of Virginia formed, October 13, 1778
- -Grand Lodge of Vermont formed October 4, 1794
- -Grand Lodge of Kentucky formed October 16, 1800
- -Andrew Jackson became Grand Master of Tennessee, October 7, 1822
- -Grand Lodge of Indian Territory formed October 6, 1873
- -Masonic Service Center opened in London, England, October 11, 1943
- -Cornerstone laid for new building to house the Iowa masonic Library, Cedar Rapids, Iowa, October 10, 1953
- -The October 8, 1957 issue of Life magazine was devoted to Freemasonry
- -The statue of Washington at Prayer, located at Valley Forge, was dedicated by the Grand Lodge of Pennsylvania on October 9, 1976
