Notable dates in Masonic History;

December, 1972

On this date Harry S. Truman, former President of the United States, Past Grand Master of Missouri, and a very active Freemason, died. He had requested a Masonic funeral, but instead the government, which handled the details, permitted a short Masonic ceremony during the funeral service.



The funeral service began with remarks by W. Hugh Mc Laughlin,

Grand Master of the Masons of Missouri. Truman was an active Mason and in 1940 was elected to the position now held by McLaughlin. McLaughlin said that the 108,000 Masons in Missouri shared the "grief and sorrow" of the Truman family.
