Jan 7, 1785.

On this date Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart received his 2nd degree. At the age of 28, in 1784, Mozart was initiated into Freemasonry in the Benevolence Lodge in Vienna, Austria. Only one month after being initiated, Mozart received his 2nd degree and just a few weeks later received his 3rd degree.
